Electrohomoeopathy (or Mattei cancer cure) is a derivative of homeopathy invented in the 19th century by Count Cesare Mattei. The name is derived from a combination of electro (referring to an electric bio-energy content supposedly extracted from plants and of therapeutic value, rather than electricity in its conventional sense) and homeopathy.^[1] So Electrohomoeopathy a complete separate system of herbal medicine like Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy. Electrohomeopathy was devised by Cesare Mattei (1809–1896) in the latter part of the 19th century. Mattei, a nobleman living in a castle in the vicinity of Bologna.^[2] Count Cesare Mattei studied natural science, anatomy, physiology, pathology, chemistry and botany. He ultimately focused on the supposed therapeutic power of "electricity" in botanical extracts. Mattei made bold, unsupported claims for the efficacy of his treatments, including the claim that his treatments offered a nonsurgical alternative to cancer.^[3] As per the Electrohomoeopathy they work on the principle that diseased organisms are far more sensitive than healthy organisms. Much like the area of skin around a cut or a graze is more sore and tender than its surrounding areas. A remedy is never given to just remove the symptoms from the body, but to work wholly on the disease and remove its cause. It therefore works on the body as a whole. Each remedy is derived from the active enzymes of several plants. When you take this complex remedy it

completely covers and controls the body. It will then move through the body via the blood and lymphatic systems and target only those areas that require it. Once the diseased part is sufficiently saturated with the remedy, it stops absorbing it. When all the parts of the body have been healed and a healthy balance restored, the medicine itself is no longer absorbed. Therefore, there are absolutely no risks of over-dosing, side effects or drug dependency. Electrohomoeopathic remedies purify the lymph and blood systems and can find and destroy the gravest of disorders. They can also help prevent disease by keeping the body pure and giving it a healthy balance.^[4]

Cohobation A Unique Filtration Process In Electrohomoeopathy

The medicines are prepared by a specific process called the 'cohobation' which was introduced by Dr. Theoparastus Von Honheim (Paracelsus) in which the living energies of the plant remain in the essences so obtained. Spagyric remedies were originally created by fermenting parts of wild herbs. This process produced concentrated aromatic solutions that were extracted and separated from the plant matter. After fermentation, the plant material was distilled, and the remainder dried and burned. The ashes were extracted and purified via distillation and crystallized, then recombined with the concentrated solution. As a result, the finished Spagyric essence contained the mineral constituent parts of the

plant which preserves the vital energies of the plant stored up in the essences so obtained. Because of the distillation process Spagyric medicines retain the electrolyte properties of the plants and this is critical to the healing process.

For preparation of medicines Count Mattei relied upon the Cohobation process of Paracelsus by which Spagyric tinctures of all the plants are extracted. This process is also known as cold fermentation process. From these Spagyric tinctures of 114 plants Count Mattei prepared 60 combinations in 8 groups like Scrofoloso group, Linfatico group, Angioitico group, Pettorale, Febrifugo, Vermifugo, Cancerosogroup and Venereo group. Mattei influenced by Spagyric begin to treat the patients by making the medicine with a unique process of Cohobation and ultimately coined a new concept of health and disease through the principle that, Life is in the Blood and Lymph and disease in its Vitiations and the medicine is placed between two classes of phenomenon disease and the normal state of the organism. Electrohomoeopathic medicines are also referred to as the Spagyric Homeopathic medicines, which are recognized in German as well as American Homeopathic pharmacopoeias.[5] Spagyric medicines can effectively correct the human temperament and its connected information-energy level. Chelation or hunger for micronutrients or trace elements hinders the optimization of health because of its regulatory and stimulatory influence on enzyme systems, Spagyric medicines retrieve missing mineral's information to restore the mind-body-spirit balance.^[5,6]

Dr. Peter Schleicher, immunologist from Munich opined, that Spagyric medicines are "effective in influencing and activating" psychoendoneuroimmunology (PNEI) regulation mechanisms. Scientific experiments at the Atomic Institute in Vienna showed that different plants contain different radiation patterns. Every plant possesses a quite individual field of radiation: a particular 'energy fingerprint'. In a fraction of a second this radiation power senses the 'information' embedded in our body's immune system, which is directly linked to the hormonesystem and connected with emotion.^[7]

Spagyric Medicine trigger at the quantum level, and deliver the correct information to activate self-regulation of bodily systems and mechanisms and enhancing its footprint through deep penetration and regulation of cellular functioning which influence at the deepest informational state, respectively the DNAs and RNAs, the higher states of emotional and physical health, thus, influence limbic activity, then hypothalamus and pituitary gland, and finally the sexual organs and adrenal glands, and provides the basis of self-sustainable health. According to Dr. Peter Schleicher, all levels of this PNI hierarchy can be given regulatory impulses through the help of high quality Spagyric medicines.^[8] So Electrohomoeopathy is best choice for the treatment of acute as well as chronic disease.

These electricity are applied on the nerve points of the body, positive electricity on the negative nerve point and negative on the positive nerve point.
